Webinar Goal: Effective April 12, 2017, the New York State HIV Treatment Access and Testing law reclassified HIV as a sexually transmitted disease allowing youth under 18 years of age to access HIV treatment and prevention medications like PrEP and PEP without parental consent. This webinar focuses on increasing the knowledge of NYS medical providers prescribing ARVs, PrEP and PEP about the expansion of the HIV law. Speakers from the AIDS Institute, New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, and Montefiore Medical Center will examine HIV testing, treatment, prevention, medical practice changes and Ending the Epidemic by 2020 in NYS as a result of the expansion of the law.

Target Audience: Physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, social workers, hospital administrators, PrEP/PEP Specialists, navigators, HIV test counselors, and adherence specialist. There will be an opportunity for questions and answers after the presentation.
